BETI BACHAO BETI PADHAO Report

INTRODUCTION

In 2015, the Indian government introduced the Beti Bachao, Beti Padhao (BBBP) scheme to address concerns of gender discrimination and women empowerment in the country. The name Beti Bachao, Beti Padhao translates to 'Save the girl child, educate the girl child'. The scheme aims to educate citizens against gender bias and improve efficacy of welfare services for girls. It was launched with an initial funding of Rs. 100 crore (US\$ 13.5 million).

The Beti Bachao Beti Padhao Yojana aims to achieve the following goals:

- · Improve the child sex ratio
- Ensure gender equality and women empowerment
- · Prevent gender-biased, sex selective elimination
- · Ensure survival and protection of the girl child
- Encourage education and participation of the girl child

Performance of the Scheme

The committee, chaired by Maharashtra BJP Lok Sabha MP Heena Vijaykumar Gavit, tabled its fifth report on "Empowerment of women through education with special reference to Beti Bachao, Beti Padhao Scheme" in Lok Sabha. According to the report, almost 80 per cent of the funds for the scheme has been used for its advertising and not on sectoral interventions such as in health and education for women. The committee has remarked that since its inception in 2014-15 till 2019-20, the total budgetary allocation under the scheme was Rs 848 crore, excluding the Covid-stricken financial year of 2020-21. During this period, an amount Rs 622.48 crore was released to the states.

"However, to the committee's dismay, only 25.13% of the funds, i.e. Rs 156.46 crore, has been spent by the states, reflecting not up to the mark performance of the scheme," the panel's report said. The committee further observed that out of a total of Rs 446.72 crore released during 2016- 2019, "a whopping 78.91% was spent only on media advocacy". "Though the committee understands the necessity to undertake a media campaign to spread the message of Beti Bachao, Beti Padhao among the people, they have felt that it is equally important to balance the objectives of the scheme," the report said. The panel recommended that "Since BBBP is one of the most important schemes of the government to improve child sex ratio in backward regions and ensure education of the girl children, the committee recommends that the government should, hereafter, reconsider spending on advertisements under the "Beti Bachao-Beti Padhao" scheme and should focus on planned expenditure allocation for sectoral interventions in education and health."










Photo: Leave format for students

Discipline in campus



Anti Sexual Harassment Committee




Active participation by female staff and student


REPORT ON CELEBRATING COLLEGE DAYS CELEBRATION 2022-23

Shiv Jayanti was started by Mahatma Jyotirao Phule in 1870 with the first ever event being held in Pune. Later Bal Gangadhar Tilak revived the image of Shivaji and worked to unite people against the British Raj through Shiv Jayanti.

Born on February 19, 1630 at Shivneri Fort in Pune, Shivaji managed to expand the influence of the Marathas over India through military forces, capturing and building forts and forming the Maratha navy. The warrior-king not only revived ancient Indian traditions and conventions, but also was instrumental in creating a progressive civil rule. He even promoted the usage of Marathi and Sanskrit, rather than Persian language, in court and administration. The date of his birth is celebrated as Shiv Jayanti every year.

Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Jayanti, which is a festival and public holiday of the Indian state of Maharashtra, sees citizens celebrating the birth of the warrior king through various social and cultural programmers as well as through the organization of processions in his honor.
